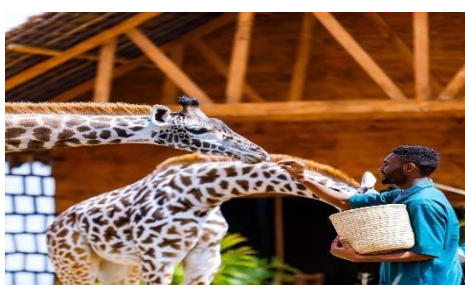

Day 6: Prison Island

Once on Changuu Island (Prison Island), your guide will explain the colorful history of the area, including the prison building – which still stands. Today the island is home to some of Zanzibar's oldest residents – descendants of the Aldabra giant tortoises that were a gift to the people of Zanzibar from the Seychelles government; some of them are rumored to have reached over a hundred years old. Look a little harder and you may also spot butterflies, bats and even the very shy duiker.
